Singleton Shire Landcare Network (SSLN) and neighbouring communities invite you to a free community event with a focus on weeds.

Local communities and landholders in the Singleton Shire and neighbouring Dungog Shire areas have been working on weed issues for many years. In many respects similar weed issues are common across these rural areas.

This weeds event has been planned by local community members for the wider community and will include speakers and demonstrations. Topics covered will be invasive grasses, biological control, aquatic weeds, riparian vine weeds, woody weeds, and weed management strategies.

Demonstrations will cover different weed control methods including an unmanned aerial drone.

Need a weed identified? Bring along a sample in a snap-lock bag for identification on the day. There will also be an opportunity to listen to and share ideas and experiences in controlling weeds from local community members. Come along for all or part of the day.



This is a great networking opportunity for those interested in getting on top of weeds, learning from others' experiences, and getting advice on the day via agency staff from Hunter Local Land Services, Dept. of Primary Industries, Upper Hunter Weeds Authority and our local councils.
